## Description of content

The following document describes the content of the data available on User Summary Tape files and Microfiche produced from the 1976 Census Micro Data Base.

A series of related tables pertaining to demographic, housing, household, family and economic characteristics are available on correspondingly named files (see Appendix A). Detailed breakdown of each characteristic variable available in terms of its class intervals is outlined in Appendix B.

Tabulations are available on both magnetic tape and microfiche media.

The media on which each tabulation is available is noted in Appendix A. Each tabulation on microfiche is either bilingual (B) or available separately in english or french (E/F) languages.

Documentation describing contents of summary tape files is also available in both official languages.

Tables are available at the following geographic levels:

### Enumeration area (EA)

The Enumeration area (EA) is the smallest individual collection unit and building block for higher geographic aggregates. There are 35,154 EA's for all of Canada.

The tables contain totals for Canada, Provinces, Federal Electoral Districts (1966 representation) and Enumeration Areas.

### Census subdivisions (SD)

The Census Subdivision (CSD) whenever possible corresponds to a municipality. There are 5,546 CSD's for all of Canada.

The tables contain totals for Canada, Provinces, Census Divisions and all Census Subdivisions.

### Census tracts (CT)

The Census tracts are stable building blocks for urban communities with population 50,000 and over. Provincial Census tracts are the complementary units for the rest of each province. There are 2,685 CT's for all of Canada. There are 1,715 PCT's for all of Canada.

The tables contain totals for Canada, Provinces, Census Metropolitan Areas, Census Agglomerations (tracted), Provincial Census tract subtotals, Census tracts and Provincial Census Tracts.

The sequence of the data on microfiche and on summary tape files is explained in detail in appendix C.

### Microfiche: format and cost

Microfiche are supplied as negative vesicular copies with images recorded at 48 times reduction. The number of pages per microfiche will be either 270 or 435 depending on the page width. The Microfiche will have computer generated indexes located in the lower right hand corner. The table number and area identifiers are featured in the readable title space.

It is recommended that at least 36 power magnification lenses be used on microfiche reader printers when desiring photocopies. This will enable copying of the 8 1/2 x 15 inch computer printout image onto an 8 1/2 x 11 photocopy. Smaller magnification of 24, for example, will be readable on a reader but possibly not as readable when printed. Additional technical advice is available on request.

To facilitate faster response and minimize handling the tables on microfiche will, with a few exceptions, be supplied only as complete tables (i.e. for all areas in the area set). Standard prices have been established to facilitate easy cost estimation. A minimum order of \$5.00 will apply. For those tables with prices of \$10.00 or more, a partial set will be supplied for the desired region(s) but the above minimum charge will apply. (see appendix D for number of microfiche per set) (Note: Prices are subject to change without notice.)
